Designing in Edmond

The Edmond Arts and Humanities Council (EAHC) and the Center has collaborated on two interior design workshops for the community. The workshops are designed to give individuals the opportunity to be creative in their own way. The workshops will be hosted at the University of Central Oklahoma on Saturday, March 6th and Saturday, March 27th. The workshops are half-day workshops that will host a local fabric shop owner to discuss fabrics, trends and a hands-on project making lamp shades. During the second workshop, paint specialists from the Edmond Home Depot will give an overview of paint colors, paint types, and they will also guide the participants in a hands-on, do-it-yourself project. University of Central Oklahoma (UCO) interior design faculty, Amy Jacobson-Peters and Kevin Steiner, will host a session on the second weekend called "trash to treasures". The workshop will highlight past creations from the seniors in the interior design program at UCO. The participants will each create their own treasure from materials supplied. All ages are welcome to the workshops. The cost of the workshops are kept low by the sponsorship from the EAHC. The registration fee is \$20 per person, per workshop includes all of the materials. Lunch is included for each of the workshops.
